

The bachelor thesis Involvement of horticultural therapy in the process of coordinated rehabilitation provided to people with disabilities in the first place defines a concept of the person with disabilities in the context of biopsychosocial view. Consequently the coordinated rehabilitation, its history and specific processes and means are presented – e.g. medical, pedagogical, social and vocational rehabilitation. Further the thesis focuses on the horticultural therapy as an auxiliary method to the process of coordinated rehabilitation provided to people with disabilities. The key concepts of horticultural therapy are defined in thesis – history, benefits and targets, garden therapist, therapeutic garden and individual approach. In the resulting part, the examples from workplaces, where the horticultural therapy is applied during the rehabilitation in the coincidence with the means of rehabilitation, are demonstrated.
