## **Abstract**

The submitted thesis describes and analyses the current legislation concerning real estate as subject to execution proceeding. It contains an analysis of the relevant provisions of the Civil Procedure Code and Execution Code relating to execution (enforcement of decisions) by the sale of real estate. It does not leave out the historical development and also presents the author's reflection on the potential amendments de lege ferenda.

The thesis further examines the role of the Land Register and, last but not least, it focuses on the legal instruments relating to real estate such as the real estate management, execution by vacation, trust and the issue of conflict of execution with bankruptcy proceeding.
