Within the perinatal period, the mother and the fetus exposed complications that may jeopardize or adversely affect their life.

The thesis is focused on maternal morbidity, from which I most impressed operative deliveries, particularly repeat cesarean (SC).

SC has now become convenient and safe public awareness and way to bring a child into the world. But is it really so?

Few people seem to think the risks for the next birth in women with a history of SC.

The number of women mainly from the 80s has risen considerably, so I think that is a current topic and discussed.
