

In my thesis I focused on the problems of the healing of the venous ulcerations. During the last years the occurrence of this disease increased among the inhabitants of the Czech Republic and today the venous ulcerations are not only the disease of the elder generation but commonly more often it affects the persons in a productive age. The multilocal hazardous factors are the main cause of the evergrowing occurrence of the disease of the vein system of the lower limbs and thus also the origin of the chronic vein insufficiency and subsequent venous ulceration. I did not want in my thesis to discover any news in the treatment of the venous ulcerations but I wanted to recall and organize by now known information into the well-arranged whole. In my thesis I offer the brief summary of the causes of the origin of the venous ulceration as well as the summary of the methods of the treatment. It is also necessary to recall the single periods of the healing of the wounds which have to be observed and supported and also to emphasize the necessity of the prevention of the by now newly originated diseases against the repeated trauma/ie. By this prevention the success of the healing of the originated disease is expressively intensified. The cooperation among the doctors (dermatologist, blood-vessel, internal medicine and surgeons) enables more high-quality and more effective treatment on the local basis. This means not only the treatment of the wound but also the treatment of the whole vein system, the complete condition of the patient and the focus on the elimination of the factors causing the origin of the venous ulcerations in the course of the prevention.
